## astronomical unit (AU) <br> 1 AU = 150,000,000 km

One $A U$ is equal to the average distance from
Earth to the Sun.
light-year (ly)
$1 \mathrm{ly}=63,000 \mathrm{AU}$
$1 \mathbf{l y}=9.5$ trillion km
One ly is equal to the distance light travels in 1 year, traveling at $300,000 \mathrm{~km}$ per second.
